### **Libraries to Offer WiFi Hotspots**

For many, home Internet access is not a possibility. In some cases, the problem is that the service is not available in their rural area. In other cases, it may be available, but cost-prohibitive. In either case, the Nottoway County Public Library System can assist with those problems.

Each branch library now has a limited number of WiFi hot spots available for borrowing, and adults with accounts in good standing are able to borrow a ZTE Warp Connect device. These hot spots connect to the Internet through the Sprint network and they will allow use for multiple devices.

There is a limit of one hot spot per household and cardholders will need to provide photo identification showing their current address. The current policy states that the loan cannot be renewed and the device must be returned during the library's open hours. Overdue devices will be immediately made inactive. In the event that a device is not returned, the borrower will be charged for the replacement cost, as stated in the contract.
