welcome new members.

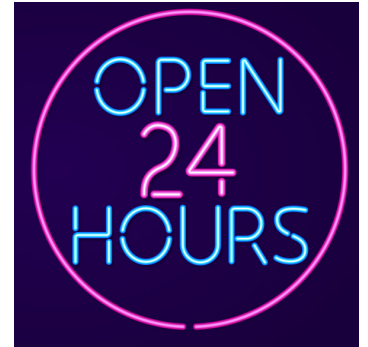

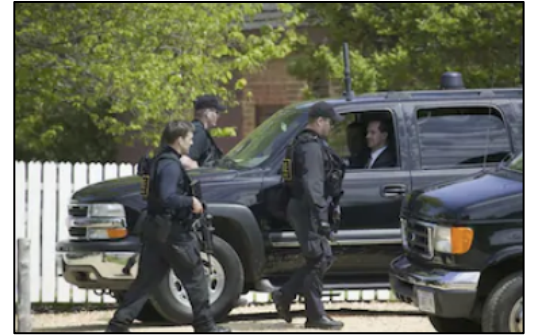
