



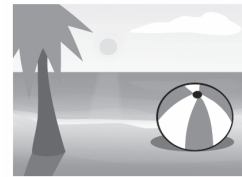

Dive Into Reading @ Your Library is the theme for this year's Summer Reading Program. This program provides an opportunity for children from kindergarten thru 8th grade to participate in a reading challenge throughout the summer months. It easy, FREE and fun. Each child is invited to stop by their local library and pick-up their Reading Challenge Log. The kick-off date is Saturday, June 6th at the "Super Scuba Divin" event.

Each child will fill out their name and phone number on the log sheet. Then they have to select the reading challenge level they would like to join. There are 5 levels: Goldfish commit to read

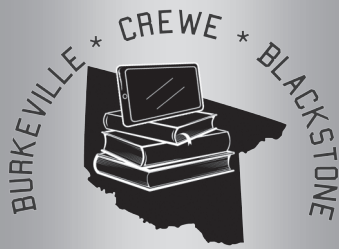
2 books per week, Starfish commit to read 3 books per week, Dolphins commit to read 5 books per week, Sharks commit to read 10 books per week and Whalers commit to read 2 young adult books per week.

The child then records the title of each book as they complete it on their log and bring it the library once a week. The librarian will initial their log and if the challenge level has been meet they get to select an incentive prize and place their name on the display board. At the end of the summer all of the children who have meet the reading challenge will have their name place in a drawing for a grand prize.



In addition there are two other events a "Living Coral Reef Aquarium" on **Saturday, July 11th** presented by Judy Goodwin and "Wonderful Water Pets" will be our final event presented by Noah's Last Stop out of Farmville on **Saturday, August 8th**.

Our weekly "Imagination Works" story times will also incorporate this theme for the summer. We invite all children to join us as we Dive into Reading this summer.

Library of Virginia

The Library of Virginia has a variety of digital collections accessible through their digital asset management system, DigiTool. These collections are searchable by keywords, creator, and title and are even more browseable with the addition of thumbnails.

Some new digital collections recently added are: Michael Miley Studio Collection; Henry Executive Papers Digital Collection, 1776-1778; Virginia Czech and Slovak Folk life Festival; Jefferson Executive Papers Digital Collection, 1779-

1781; Kaine Email Project @LVA; Governor Robert F McDonnel Administration Web Archive; WPA Historical Houses Drawings Digital Collections; World War II Poster Collection and the Rare Book Digital Collection.

Botanica is an online exhibition that provides an exploration of botanical texts and art found in the volumes of the Rare Book Collection at the library. Early herbals describe plants used for their medicinal value. The exhibition also

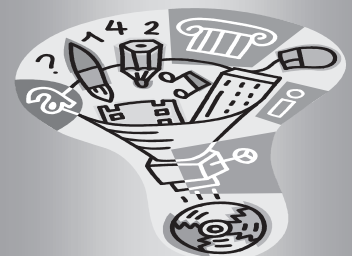
