Borrow the Internet



The Nottoway County Public Library System has a limited number of **WiFi Hotspots available for borrowing.** Adults with accounts in good standing now are able to borrow a ZTE Warp Connect device and connect to the

Internet through the Sprint network. There is a limit of **one device per household** and the current policy states that the loan cannot be renewed. Overdue devices will be immediately made inactive.

Cardholders will need to **provide photo identification** showing their current address and must agree to return the device during the library's open hours. Should a device not be returned, the borrower will be charged for the replacement cost as described in the contract.

Coming Soon...Hoopla!

Fans of digital content will be excited to hear that we will soon have even more to offer. **In addition to the eBooks** offered from Overdrive **and the electronic magazine subscriptions** (provided by the Library of Virginia) that are available from Zinio, Nottoway County Public Library **cardholders will soon be able to stream movies, music, and television shows.** There is no cost to the cardholder – this “trial subscription” is **funded jointly by the Friends of Crewe Library and the Friends of the Library, Blackstone.**
