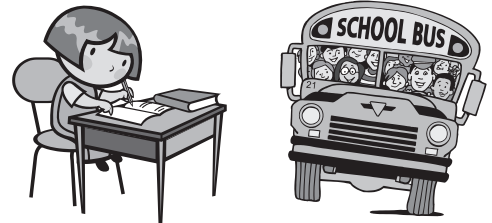

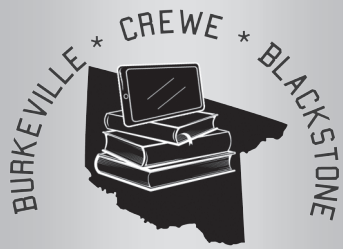
In addition all of the books at The Book End at 102 Maple Street in

The Great War: The Printmakers of WWI

July 28 —November 9,
2014

Complimentary admission. This exhibition marks the centenary of the commencement of World War I on July 28, 1914. Rather than presenting a chronology of events, this exhibition focuses on how artists—many of whom witnessed combat firsthand as official War

Artists—represent the moods and transformative experiences particular to this global conflict. The European and American printmakers included here created an invaluable visual record of the war as conducted on the frontlines and the mobilized home front. All of the prints come from the Frank Raysor collection, a promised gift to VMFA.

The library website will have a totally new look with updated graphics that will include the library's new logo, reorganized information with new drop downs, a new calendar feature and contact format.

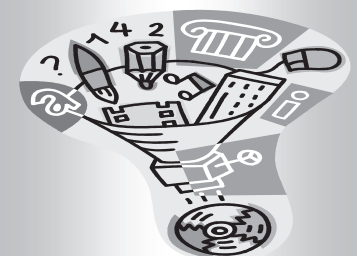
When completed patrons will also be able to search the library collections database which will also have a new look.
