NOTTOWAY LITERACY PROGRAM ANNOUNCES NEW DIRECTOR

Effective July 1, 2016 Sally Crager will become the new Director of the Nottoway County Literacy Program (NCLP). Sally has worked as a bookkeeper/receptionist, teaching assistant, home healthcare worker and at Southside Virginia Community College. She resides in Blackstone.

Sally succeeds Robin Sapp who had served as NCLP Director since 2008 before joining the Cumberland Library as Director.

For over twenty-five years the NCLP has promoted and fostered literacy in Nottoway County through volunteer teaching of low-literacy adults and those for whom English is not their native language. Adult students have obtained their GED, , qualified for college or other training, improved job opportunities, and gained U.S. citizenship as well as other achievements.

Programs include free, confidential, one-on-one tutoring by certified literacy tutors, English-as-a-second language and computer literacy classes.
