


please be sure to check with us from time to time - we'll let you know as soon as there is a definitive schedule in place.

That's true. But also not. You can, of course, get many ebooks online...and your library can help with that. Your library card provides free access to more than 800,000 ebooks from Overdrive and Hoopla, and more than 500,000 eAudios.

What's Next?

To Better Serve You...

We have been loaning more than books for nearly six years, and **mobile hot spots** have proven to be quite popular. The popularity of the devices combined with the limited quantity means that, unfortunately, there is nearly always a waiting list. In order to shorten the time borrowers spend waiting, a **new borrowing policy will become effective March 1**.

It is vital that you **keep your contact information up to date**. When a hot spot arrives for you, **you will have seven (calendar) days to pick it up** - after that, the next person on the list will be contacted and your name will move to the end of the list.

It is equally important that you **return the hot spot on time**. A failure to return the device on time will be noted on your account. After March 1, **failing to return the device two times will result in the loss of (hot spot) borrowing privileges** for a period of three months.

We appreciate your help in keeping the waiting list short and the hot spots circulating.
