The Nottoway County Public Library offers a wide selection of **eBooks and digital magazines.**

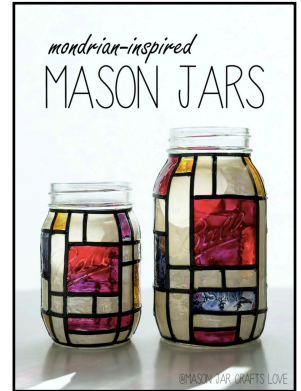

We’re still looking at the calendar to see what else can be fit in this month, but for now, read on to learn about what’s planned so far.

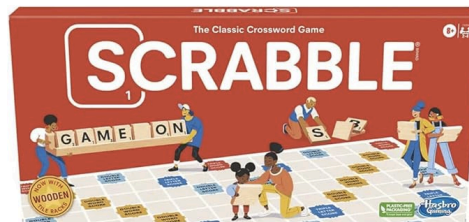
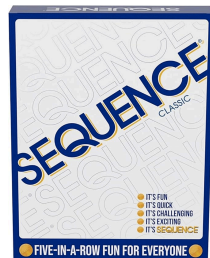

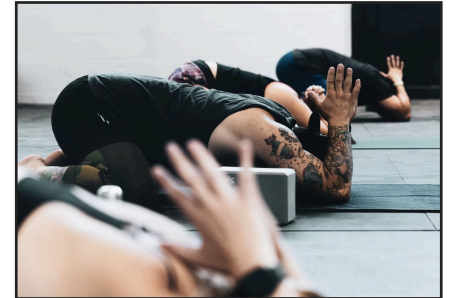
