## Speaking of the Great Outdoors...

Have you heard about Trail Quest, a new(ish) program offered by the Virginia State Parks? The idea is simple, and the program is self-paced...all you need to do is visit parks around the state, then record your visit on the website (<u>https://www.dcr.virginia.gov/state-parks/trail-quest</u>).



You'll be rewarded with up to five Virginia State Park pins: one after your first park visit and others after visiting 5, 10, 20 and all parks. Not only that, once you visit all the parks, you earn the Master Hiker designation and will be recognized at a park of your choice by a member of park's staff.
