The waters of Virginia connect communities and people across landscapes, providing an endless source of adventure and fun. There are 41 total state parks, with 31 offering the Paddle Quest program. Just visit a Park and participate in a paddle based adventure, then record your visit at the State Park Adventures page. You earn a sticker for paddling at just five parks, and that's easy to do...just look at the nearby opportunities this month:

Sept 2 (2 - 5 pm) – Exploring the James River Canoe Paddle - James River State Park (Canoe Launch)

Sept 4 (9 - 11 am) - Rise & Shine Paddle - Pocahontas (Swift Creek Boat Launch)

Sept 9 (9 - 10 am) - Kayak Intro and Lake Tour - Bear Creek (Boat House)

Sept 16 (9 - 11 am) - Let's Go Canoeing - Occoneechee (Interpretive Center)

Sept 29 (5:30 - 7 pm) - Sunset Canoe Tour - Powhatan (Launch A Parking)

Sept 30 (11 - 12:30 pm) - Canoe Tour - Twin Lakes (Prince Edward boat ramp)
