Are the Kids Bored?

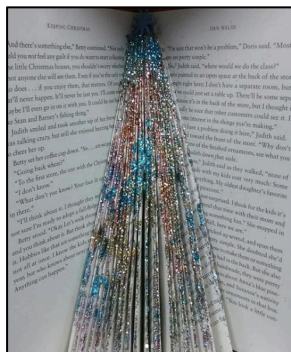
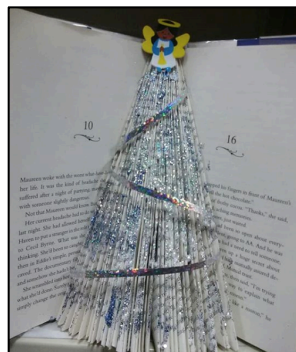
Be sure to bring them to the **Blackstone Library on Tuesday, January 7 at 4:30** for some good, old-fashioned fun playing **board games**.
