FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit Program Fact Sheet

On February 25th, the FCC unanimously adopted a \$3.2 billion federal initiative to help lower the cost of high-speed internet for eligible households during the on-going COVID-19 pandemic.

What Is the Benefit?

- Up to \$50/month discount for broadband services; and
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider.

The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per eligible household.

Who Is Eligible for the Emergency Broadband Benefit?

A household is eligible if one member of the household:

Qualifies for the [Lifeline](#) program

Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, or did so in the 2019-2020 school year;

Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020

Received a Federal Pell Grant in the current award year; or

When Can Eligible Households Sign Up?

The FCC expects the Emergency Broadband Benefit program to be open to eligible households before the end of April, 2021. Please check the FCC's website, www.fcc.gov/broadbandbenefit, regularly for the latest information.
