## 1000 Books Before Kindergarten

This month, the Nottoway County Public Library System is kicking off its 1000 Books **Before Kindergarten** program. This early literacy program is self-paced and is intended to encourage parents and caregivers, grandparents and siblings to read to children who have not yet entered kindergarten.

Studies have shown that not only does reading aloud to children help to build their

language skills and vocabulary, but it also helps to stimulate brain development and strengthen bonding between reader and child.

To participate, just pick up a reading log at any branch location and get started tracking each book read to your preschool child. Each time you trade in a completed log, your child will receive a small prize, and when you reach 1000 books, he or she will be given a free book to take home and add to your home library collection.
