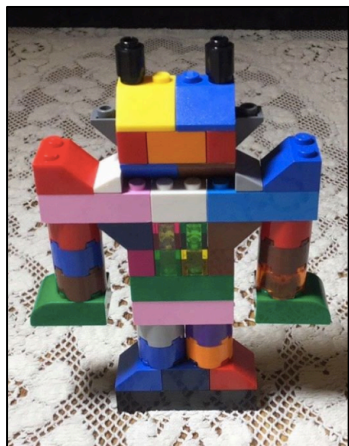

144 Lives Saved

The Crewe Library had planned a mobile blood drive for April 8, but because of the need for social distancing, it could not be held as planned. Instead, we reached out to the Crewe VFD, and the department was kind enough to allow the use of their space. **Community response was overwhelmingly positive;** a second drive was quickly planned and took place two weeks later at the Burkeville Baptist Church. A combined 48 units of blood were collected at the two drives, meaning that 144 lives were (potentially) saved by the good citizens of Nottoway County.
