# What's Next?



## From the Desk of Kathy Oliver...

...Many of us are putting our gardens to bed and dreaming about next Spring. But hold on, we still have temps in the 70's and many things are still abundant, especially herbs! So how can we preserve those flavors into winter? One way is to use our freezers. Basil does not hold onto that basil flavor very well when dried. So pesto is the answer. Using pine nuts, extra virgin olive oil, some lemon, garlic, parmesan, salt and pepper and adding 4 cups of basil leaves...use a food processor or blender to grind everything up. I enjoy a first taste right away...great on pasta, in sauces, soups and stews. But I freeze most of it in ice cube trays. Once frozen, the pesto cubes can be taken out of the trays and stored back in the freezer in a gallon sized freezer bag. Just pop a cube into a sauce while making for aromatic basil flavor any time of year. Or melt it in the microwave and slather it on your pizza. Enjoy!
