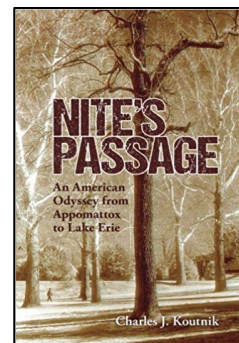

This Month at the LVA

Becoming American:

A Documentary Film and Discussion Series on Our Immigration Experience

Becoming American is a **free, public program** designed to engage and enlighten audiences by **screening documentary films that represent a selection of diverse immigration experiences** drawn from both the past and the present. Each screening is held in the lecture hall from 5:30-7:00 PM with discussions led by staff from VCU Globe (Virginia Commonwealth University's Global Education Office).

The series begins on **April 2nd** with a screening of *New York: A Documentary Film*. The film on **April 9th** is *My American Girls*. The final film in the spring series, *The New Americans*, is scheduled for **April 16th**.

Becoming American is a project of City Lore in collaboration with the Immigration and Ethnic History Society and the International Coalition of the Sites of Conscience. The project has been made possible by a major grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities: Exploring the Human Endeavor and complements the Library's current exhibition, *New Virginians: 1619-2019 & Beyond*.
