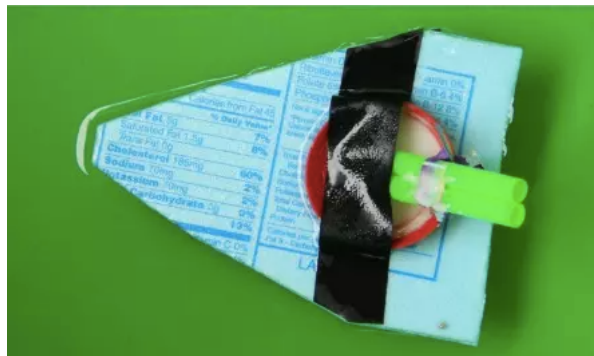


## Explore Your Artistic Side

Brainfuse **JobNow™** is designed to support every step of the job search process. **JobNow™** features live online coaches who assist in resume/cover letter preparation, help prepare for job interviews, and more.

**VetNow™** is an incredible resource for veterans of the armed services. The site includes a veteran navigator to enable you to learn about VA benefits and community resources, job coaching to aid your transition to civilian life, and a SkillSurfer tool to offer skills building with a library of lessons, videos, tests, and more.

Learners of all ages also have access to **HelpNow™**. This an online tutoring service offering individual academic assistance in core subjects, a 24/7 writing lab, practice tests for skill-building, and more.
